### National Tree Day Celebrations

Students and staff from the Elliston Area School planted 250 Sheoaks on Friday 30th April 2010 on Nigel and Deb May's property 'Three Lakes' as part of the National Tree Day celebrations across Australia.

The Year 7,8,9's planted the trees in little over 2 hours, their enthusiasm for the job is to be commended. The tree seedlings were grown by the students in the school nursery from locally collected seed and were in excellent condition. The trees were planted in an area that was direct seeded in 2007 where mostly acacias and templetonias germinated, the sheoaks have been planted in and around the existing growth to provide a more diverse range of flora in the area.

The students used potta-putkis (provided by Greening Australia) to create a hole in the ground, the tube stock once dipped into water crystals were placed down the potta-putki tube, then firmed into the ground. Water was then added and a tree guard placed over each seedling.

A sausage sizzle cooked over a bed of coals was enjoyed by all after the planting was done. There are a range of seedlings available at the school, please contact Caroline Gillett for further information
