UPDATE TO VAST DIGITAL TV SERVICE INFORMATION

A check of the Federal Government website www.digitalready.gov.au has shown me that Elliston residents cannot apply for the satellite subsidy scheme until January next year. Originally we were told that one could apply for the subsidy in September and this is the information which I gave out in the Echo last year.

For those people that have had the VAST satellite equipment installed and are already receiving digital free to air TV, you might be interested in printing out a list of the channels which are currently available. You can download a pdf file which I have created which can be opened and printed out by computers which have a pdf file reader such as Adobe Reader or FoxIT. 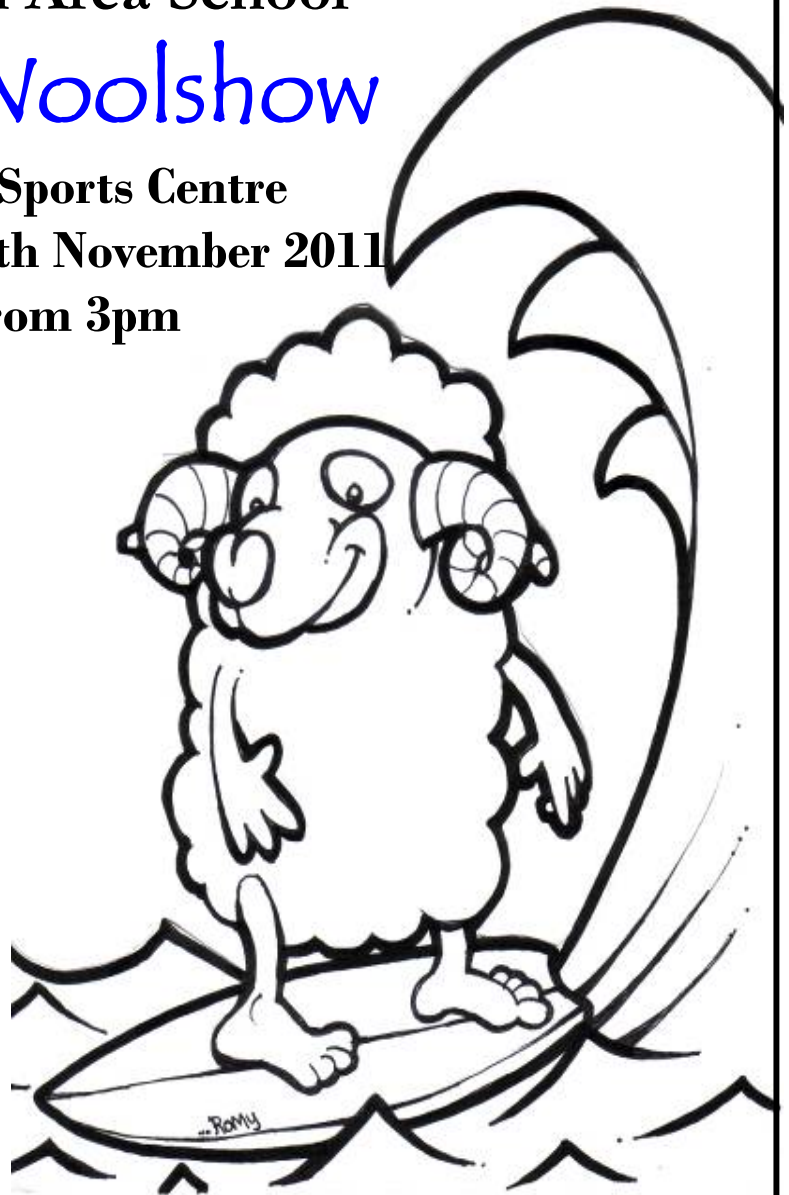
